1 AN ACT Relating to placing averse agents in antifreeze; and adding 2 a new section to chapter 70.106 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.106 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 (1) Any antifreeze product containing by weight ten percent or more 7 ethylene glycol and manufactured in this state on or after July 1, 8 2008, or sold in this state on or after July 1, 2009, must also contain 9 an aversive agent, approved by the director, in a concentration 10 sufficient to render that antifreeze product unpalatable to humans and 11 animals.

12 (2) If the director finds or has probable cause to believe that any 13 antifreeze product being sold in this state fails to comply with 14 subsection (1) of this section, the director is authorized to order 15 that product's removal from retail shelf space.
