- 7 <u>(1) It is the responsibility of the department ((shall)) to</u> 8 designate the areas of state-owned aquatic lands that are available for 9 geoduck harvesting by licensed geoduck harvesters in accordance with
- 10 <u>this</u> chapter ((79.90 RCW)).
- 11 (2)(a) It is the primary responsibility of the department of fish
- 12 and wildlife to:
- (i) Identify commercial geoduck tracks;
- 14 (ii) Conduct all geoduck resource assessments and recovery and
- 15 mortality rate studies;
- 16 <u>(iii) Set the total allowable catch limits for the harvest of</u>
- 17 <u>wildstock geoducks from state-owned aquatic lands.</u>
- 18 (b) The department may not substitute information from sources
