AN ACT Relating to providing excise tax exemptions for log haulers; adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.16 RCW; providing an effective date; and providing expiration dates.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 (1) This chapter does not apply to amounts received by a person in 9 respect to the business of log hauling in the state of Washington. To 10 qualify for the exemption, the person's vehicle must be subject to the 11 licensing fee in schedule A of RCW 46.16.070 and the logs must be 12 processed in the state of Washington.

13 (2) This section expires June 30, 2010.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.16 RCW 15 to read as follows:

(1) This chapter does not apply to amounts received by a person inrespect to the business of log hauling in the state of Washington. To

1 qualify for the exemption, the person's vehicle must be subject to the 2 licensing fee in schedule A of RCW 46.16.070 and the logs must be 3 processed in the state of Washington.

4 (2) This section expires June 30, 2010.

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2008.
