## HOUSE BILL 3353

State of Washington 60th Legislature 2008 Regular Session

AN ACT Relating to eliminating the state property tax levy and protecting education funding; creating new sections; and repealing RCW 84.52.065, 84.52.067, 84.52.068, and 84.48.080.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that owners of real property, including homeowners, throughout Washington state have 6 experienced rapid increases in property taxes and are in need of 7 8 meaningful relief. The legislature intends by this act to reduce the property tax burden by eliminating the state property tax levy, while 9 10 providing that education funding levels are not affected or supplanted 11 as a result of repealing the state property tax levy.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. The following acts or parts of acts are each 13 repealed:

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The repeal of the state property tax levy in 10 section 2 of this act does not affect or supplant education funding 11 levels.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. This act applies to taxes levied for 13 collection in 2009 and thereafter.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. If any repealers in this act, or any sections enacted or affected by this act, are enacted in a 2008 legislative session that do not take cognizance of this act, the code reviser must prepare a bill for introduction in the 2009 or 2010 legislative session that incorporates any such amendments into the reorganization adopted by this act and corrects any references made obsolete as a result of enacting this act.

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
