- 1 AN ACT Relating to establishing the eastern Washington state
- 2 veterans' cemetery; adding a new section to chapter 72.36 RCW; and
- 3 creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature recognizes the unique
- 6 sacrifices made by veterans and their family members. The legislature
- 7 recognizes further that while all veterans are entitled to interment at
- 8 the Tahoma national cemetery, veterans and families living in eastern
- 9 Washington desire a veterans' cemetery location closer to their homes.
- 10 The legislature requested and received the department of veterans
- 11 affairs feasibility study and business plan outlining the need and
- 12 feasibility and now intends to establish a state veterans' cemetery to
- 13 honor veterans in their final resting place.
- 14 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 72.36 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 (1) The department shall establish and maintain in this state an
- 17 eastern Washington state veterans' cemetery.

1 (2) All honorably discharged veterans, as defined by RCW 41.04.007, 2 and their spouses are eligible for interment in the eastern Washington 3 state veterans' cemetery.

- (3) The department shall collect all federal veterans' burial benefits and other available state or county resources.
- (4) The department shall adopt rules defining the services available, eligibility, fees, and the general operations associated with the eastern Washington state veterans' cemetery.
