1 AN ACT Relating to requiring initiative and referendum signature 2 gatherers to wear identification that indicates whether they are paid 3 workers or are volunteers; and adding a new section to chapter 29A.72 4 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 29A.72 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 (1) Any person circulating initiative or referendum petitions in 9 order to get signatures on the petitions must wear an identification 10 tag that prominently displays the following information:

(a) If the person is paid for circulating the petitions, the person must identify that he or she is a paid signature gatherer and identify who is paying the person for work as a signature gatherer; or

(b) If the person is not paid for circulating the petitions, the
person must identify that he or she is a volunteer signature gatherer.
(2) For the purposes of this section, a person is considered a paid

17 signature gatherer if he or she receives a salary or other

- 1 remuneration, including an honorarium or gift, for work circulating
- 2 initiative or referendum petitions for signatures.
