- 7 ((\(\frac{(1)}{(1)}\)) (a) Manufactures, sells, or disposes of or possesses any 8 instrument or weapon of the kind usually known as slung shot, sand 9 club, or metal knuckles, or spring blade knife, or any knife the blade 10 of which is automatically released by a spring mechanism or other 11 mechanical device, or any knife having a blade which opens, or falls, 12 or is ejected into position by the force of gravity, or by an outward,
- downward, or centrifugal thrust or movement;
- 14 $((\frac{2}{2}))$ (b) Furtively carries with intent to conceal any dagger, 15 dirk, pistol, or other dangerous weapon; or
- 16 (((3))) (c) Uses any contrivance or device for suppressing the
- 17 noise of any firearm,
- is guilty of a gross misdemeanor punishable under chapter 9A.20 RCW.
