- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.60A RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The department shall:

- 7 (a) Develop and maintain a current list of veteran-owned 8 businesses; and
 - (b) Make the list available on the department's public web site.
- 10 (2) In order to qualify as a veteran-owned business, the business 11 must be at least fifty-one percent owned and controlled by:
- 12 (a) A veteran as defined in RCW 41.04.007; or
- 13 (b) An active or reserve member in any branch of the armed forces 14 of the United States, including the national guard, coast guard, and 15 armed forces reserves.
- 16 (3) The department shall create a logo for the purpose of 17 identifying veteran-owned businesses to the public. The department 18 shall put the logo on an adhesive sticker or decal suitable for display

- in a business window and distribute the stickers or decals to veteranowned businesses listed with the department.
- 3 (4) Businesses may submit an application on a form prescribed by 4 the department for inclusion on the list.
- 5 (5) The department may adopt rules necessary to implement this 6 section.
