- AN ACT Relating to use of public funds for political purposes; and amending RCW 42.17.128.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.17.128 and 1993 c 2 s 24 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- Public funds, whether derived through taxes, fees, penalties, or any other sources, shall not be used to finance political campaigns for
- 8 state ((or local)) office. The legislative authority of a county,
- 9 city, town, or district may establish a program allowing the use of
- 10 public funds to finance campaigns for local office through adoption of
- 11 an ordinance or resolution. The ordinance or resolution must be
- 12 submitted to and approved by a vote of the people at the next general
- 13 <u>election in the form of a referendum for those jurisdictions that have</u>
- 14 referendum power, and in the form of an advisory ballot for those
- 15 jurisdictions without referendum power. A county, city, town, or
- 16 district that establishes a program to publicly finance local office
- 17 political campaigns may only use funds derived from local sources to
