- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) A person shall not be charged, subject to civil forfeiture, or 7 otherwise prosecuted for a violation of this chapter if:
 - (a) The person was a witness to a drug overdose;
- 9 (b) The person reasonably believed that the overdose would result 10 in an imminent threat to the health or life of the overdose victim;
- 11 (c) The person reported the drug overdose to law enforcement or 12 summoned medical assistance at the time it was witnessed; and
- 13 (d) All evidence of the specific violation was gained as a result 14 of the person's report.
- 15 (2) This section does not apply to prosecutions under RCW 16 69.50.415.
- 17 (3) This section does not apply to prosecutions where the person
