- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 3

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The department of veterans affairs shall 4 5 study efficient ways to increase the department's access to veterans, and to increase veterans' access to the state and federal assistance 6 7 programs for which they may be eligible. By December 1, 2007, the legislature with 8 department shall submit the a report to recommendations. The report shall address:
- 10 (1) How the department can achieve a goal of identifying all 11 veterans in the state within five years;
- 12 (2) How the department can efficiently identify veterans as their population in the state continues to grow; 13
- 14 (3) How the department can identify veterans through referrals from 15 other state agencies that currently provide services to veterans;
- (4) How the department can effectively inform veterans of the state 16 and federal programs for which they may be eligible; 17
- (5) The potential costs and savings to the state that would result 18 19 if the department's recommendations were undertaken; and
