- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. It is the intent of the legislature to limit
- the amount of information that is made public in property assessments 6
- 7 in order to protect property owners from being the victims of crime.
- 8 Currently, property assessment information has included photographs
- that have contained pictures of property owners' children, vehicles 9
- 10 with license plate numbers, and other related personal information. In
- 11 order to prevent property owners from being potential victims of crime,
- 12 this type of information must not be made public.

- 13 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 36.21 RCW 14 to read as follows:
- 15 When assessing the value of real property, the county assessor or agents of the assessor shall not publicize any personal information
- 17 related to the property owner that is not in relation to the assessment

- 3 (1) Pictures of children, automobiles, pets, alarm systems, or 4 floor plans; and
- 5 (2) Information contained in print or picture that may assist a person in committing a crime.
