AN ACT Relating to an exemption from unemployment compensation for certain small performing arts industries; and adding a new section to chapter 50.04 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 50.04 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 The term "employment" does not include any person engaged in 8 activities related to a performance sponsored by an employer with North American industry classification system code 711110, 711120, or 712110, 9 10 who receives no remuneration for these activities other than a nominal stipend. The stipend is presumed to defray the individual's incidental 11 12 expenses involved in performing including, but not limited to, meals, transportation, lodging, costumes, supplies, child care, and related 13 This section does not apply to employers with more than 14 expenses. 15 three individuals in their employ during any portion of a day during 16 the calendar year.

17 For purposes of this section, "stipend" means a fixed sum of money

1 paid periodically to defray expenses.
