- 6 (1) An institution of higher education may not agree to, or be 7 subject to, the rules or policies of any organization, association, or 8 any other type of entity, nor make a contract with any party, that 9 dictates the terms, value, and conditions of student athlete 10 scholarships relating to any of the following:
- 11 (a) The terms or duration of a scholarship or stipend the value of which is below the actual cost of attendance at that institution;
- 13 (b) The amount earned from bona fide employment not associated with their sport;
  - (c) Health insurance;

- 16 (d) The ability to obtain licensed representation in making career 17 choices;
- 18 (e) The ability to transfer to another institution of higher

education if a head coach leaves the school of attendance or anticipated attendance.

- (2) No institution of higher education that maintains an intercollegiate athletics program may impose, or submit to the imposition of, a penalty or other sanction on a student athlete for a violation of a rule or code of conduct of an intercollegiate athletics association that was not committed by that student athlete.
- 8 (3) As used in this section, "penalty or other sanction" includes, 9 but is not necessarily limited to, the cancellation or forfeiting of an 10 athletic event.
- 11 (4) This section may be known and cited as the "student athletes' 12 bill of rights."
