AN ACT Relating to clarifying the business and occupation taxation of property management companies in regards to on-site property managers' wages and benefits; and amending RCW 82.04.394.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 82.04.394 and 1998 c 338 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) This chapter does not apply to amounts received by a property 8 management company from ((the owner of)) a property <u>owner</u> for gross 9 wages and benefits paid directly to or on behalf of on-site personnel 10 from property management trust accounts that are required to be 11 maintained under RCW 18.85.310.

12 (2) As used in this section, "on-site personnel" means a person who meets all of the following conditions: (a) The person works primarily 13 14 on-site at ((the owner's property)) one or more properties managed by 15 the property management company; (b) the person's duties include leasing property units, maintaining ((the)) property, collecting rents, 16 or similar activities; and (c) under a written property management 17 18 agreement: (i) The person's compensation is the ultimate obligation of 19 the property owner and not the property manager; (ii) the property

1 manager is liable for payment only as agent of the owner; and (iii) the 2 property manager is the agent of the owner with respect to the on-site 3 personnel and that all actions, including, but not limited to, hiring, 4 firing, compensation, and conditions of employment, taken by the 5 property manager with respect to the on-site personnel are subject to 6 the approval of the property owner.

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
