- AN ACT Relating to military monuments; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 38.40 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the military and
- 5 its personnel play a vital role in defending the lives and freedom of
- 6 all Americans. The legislature intends to honor the contribution of
- 7 the military by the establishment of appropriate monuments located on
- 8 state property near each military base in the state.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 38.40 RCW 10 to read as follows:
- 11 The military department, in consultation with the department of
- 12 transportation, shall erect and maintain a monument to be constructed
- 13 from permanent materials, such as masonry, stone, or concrete, at an
- 14 appropriate location on state property near each military base in the
- 15 state. The purpose of the monument is to alert persons as to the
- 16 presence and location of the military base. The monument, at a
- 17 minimum, shall identify the military base's name, branch of service,
- 18 and appropriate military insignia. To the extent possible, and in

- 1 conformance with applicable traffic safety standards as determined by
- 2 the department of transportation, these monuments shall be uniform in
- 3 size and design throughout the state.
