1 AN ACT Relating to limiting taxing districts' regular property tax 2 levy increases; reenacting and amending RCW 84.55.005 and 84.55.0101; 3 creating a new section; repealing RCW 84.55.092; and declaring an 4 emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 Sec. 1. RCW 84.55.005 and 1997 c 393 s 20 and 1997 c 3 s 201 are 7 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

8 As use

As used in this chapter:

9 (1) "Inflation" means the percentage change in the implicit price 10 deflator for personal consumption expenditures for the United States as 11 published for the most recent twelve-month period by the bureau of 12 economic analysis of the federal department of commerce in September of 13 the year before the taxes are payable;

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(2) "Limit factor" means:

15 (a) For taxing districts with a population of less than ten 16 thousand in the calendar year prior to the assessment year, one hundred 17 ((six)) one percent;

18 (b) For taxing districts for which a limit factor is authorized

under RCW 84.55.0101, the lesser of the limit factor authorized under that section or one hundred ((six)) one percent;

3 (c) For all other districts, the lesser of one hundred ((six)) one
4 percent or one hundred percent plus inflation; and

5 (3) "Regular property taxes" has the meaning given it in RCW 6 84.04.140.

7 Sec. 2. RCW 84.55.0101 and 1997 c 3 s 204 are each reenacted and 8 amended to read as follows:

9 Upon a finding of substantial need, the legislative authority of a taxing district other than the state may provide for the use of a limit 10 11 factor under this chapter of one hundred ((six)) one percent or less 12 unless an increase greater than this limit is approved by the voters at an election as provided in RCW 84.55.050. In districts with 13 legislative authorities of four members or less, two-thirds of the 14 members must approve an ordinance or resolution under this section. In 15 16 districts with more than four members, a majority plus one vote must 17 approve an ordinance or resolution under this section. The new limit factor shall be effective for taxes collected in the following year 18 19 only.

20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. RCW 84.55.092 (Protection of future levy 21 capacity) and 1998 c 16 s 3, 1988 c 274 s 4, & 1986 c 107 s 3 are each 22 repealed.

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate 24 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 25 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 26 immediately.

27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply both 28 prospectively and retroactively to taxes levied for collection in 2002 29 and thereafter.

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
