1 AN ACT Relating to children working for their parents; and amending 2 RCW 26.28.060.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 26.28.060 and 2007 c 464 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) Every person who shall employ, and every parent, guardian or 6 7 other person having the care, custody or control of such child, who 8 shall permit to be employed, by another, any child under the age of fourteen years at any labor whatever, in or in connection with any 9 10 store, shop, factory, mine or any inside employment not connected with 11 farm or house work, without the written permit thereto of a judge of a 12 superior court of the county wherein such child may live, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. 13

14 (2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to children 15 employed as:

16 (a) Actors or performers in film, video, audio, or theatrical 17 productions; ((or))

18 (b) Youth soccer referees who have been certified by a national

- 1 referee certification program; or
- 2 (c) Workers for, and under the supervision of, their parents.
