- 8 (1) In order to facilitate hunting and fishing opportunities for terminally or seriously ill children, the director may provide any 9 10 licenses, tags, permits, stamps, and fees without charge or a The director may only take such an action upon 11 transaction fee. 12 request by a nonprofit organization seeking to provide a hunting or fishing opportunity, or both, to one or more terminally or seriously 13 14 ill children who are each eighteen years old or younger.
- 15 (2) The director may accept special permits or other special hunting opportunities, including raffle tags, auction tags, 16 multiple season opportunities from donors seeking to facilitate hunting 17 opportunities for terminally or seriously ill children. The director 18

- shall distribute these donations pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.
- 3 (3) The director may take other actions consistent with 4 facilitating hunting and fishing opportunities for terminally or
- 5 seriously ill children. These actions may include, but are not limited
- 6 to, entering into agreements with willing landowners, pursuant to RCW
- 7 77.12.320, to provide hunting opportunities for terminally or seriously
- 8 ill children.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act may be known and cited as the 10 Senator Bob Oke memorial act.
