- 1 AN ACT Relating to a leasehold excise tax exemption for nonprofit
- 2 folk, ethnic, and traditional arts festivals; and adding a new section
- 3 to chapter 82.29A RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.29A RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 All leasehold interests used by a nonprofit organization
- 8 established for the sole mission of organizing, sponsoring, or
- 9 conducting an annual festival or fair dedicated to folk, ethnic, and
- 10 traditional arts, including performing arts are exempt from tax under
- 11 this chapter. "Organizing, sponsoring, or conducting," for purposes of
- 12 this section, means activities necessary to obtain artists and vendors
- 13 for a festival, archiving of festival performances, sales of
- 14 memorabilia related to the festival or festival performances, and
- 15 other, related activities, but only if the funds derived by the
- 16 organization from these activities are used solely for the support and
- 17 enhancement of the mission of the organization.
