AN ACT Relating to exempting certain military housing from property and leasehold excise taxes; amending RCW 84.36.010; and adding a new section to chapter 82.29A RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 84.36.010 and 2004 c 236 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) All property belonging exclusively to the United States, the 8 state, or any county or municipal corporation; all property belonging exclusively to any federally recognized Indian tribe located in the 9 state, if that property is used exclusively for essential government 10 services; all state route number 16 corridor transportation systems and 11 12 facilities constructed under chapter 47.46 RCW; and all property under 13 a financing contract pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW or recorded 14 agreement granting immediate possession and use to the public bodies 15 listed in this section or under an order of immediate possession and 16 use pursuant to RCW 8.04.090; is exempt from taxation. All property belonging exclusively to a foreign national government is exempt from 17 18 taxation if that property is used exclusively as an office or residence

1 for a consul or other official representative of the foreign national 2 government, and if the consul or other official representative is a 3 citizen of that foreign nation.

4 (2) For the purposes of this section, "essential government 5 services" means services such as tribal administration, public 6 facilities, fire, police, public health, education, sewer, water, 7 environmental and land use, transportation, and utility services.

(3) For the purposes of this section, "property belonging 8 exclusively to the United States "includes property, both real and 9 personal, together with all improvements thereto, regardless of the 10 ownership of either, used for the housing of military personnel and 11 their families, as provided by the military housing privatization 12 13 initiative of 1996, 10 U.S.C. Secs. 2871 through 2885, as amended. Such improvements, in addition to the actual housing units, include, 14 but are not limited to, facilities related to the housing units, such 15 as housing maintenance facilities, housing rental and management 16 offices, parks, and community centers. 17

18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.29A RCW
19 to read as follows:

20 The following leasehold interests are exempt from taxes imposed 21 under this chapter: All leasehold interests in any property belonging exclusively to the United States, including property owned in part by 22 23 the United States, together with all improvements thereto, used for the 24 housing of military personnel and their families, as provided by the 25 military housing privatization initiative of 1996, 10 U.S.C. Secs. 2871 26 through 2885, as amended. Such improvements, in addition to the actual 27 housing units, include, but are not limited to, facilities related to the housing units, such as housing maintenance facilities, housing 28 29 rental and management offices, parks, and community centers.

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
