AN ACT Relating to the liability of persons rescued from flood waters on roadways; and adding a new section to chapter 46.61 RCW. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 (1) A person is liable for the cost incurred by the state, local 7 municipality, or public agency that rescues that person from flood 8 waters on a roadway if:

9 (a) The rescue was necessary because the person who was rescued 10 intentionally ignored warning signs; and

(b) By the person obeying warning signs, the need for the rescue would have been avoided.

(2) A person shall not be liable for the costs associated with hisor her rescue if:

15 (a) His or her failure to heed the warning signs was due to an 16 emergency; or

17 (b) Under the circumstances, a reasonable person would have ignored

1 the warning signs.
