AN ACT Relating to the taxation of honey beekeepers; amending RCW 82.04.330, 82.08.865, and 82.12.865; adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 Sec. 1. RCW 82.04.330 and 2001 c 118 s 3 are each amended to read 7 as follows:

8 (1)(a) This chapter shall not apply to any farmer ((that)) who:
 9 (i) Sells any agricultural product at wholesale; or ((to any farmer
 10 who))

11 (ii) Grows, raises, or produces agricultural products owned by 12 others, such as custom feed operations.

13 (b) This chapter shall not apply to amounts derived from the 14 wholesale sale of honey bee products by a person who owns or keeps bee 15 colonies and who does not qualify for an exemption under (a) of this 16 subsection in respect to such sales.

17 (c) The exemptions provided in (a) and (b) of this subsection shall 18 not apply to any person selling such products at retail or to any 19 person selling manufactured substances or articles.

18 (h) "Honey bee products" means queen honey bees, packaged honey 19 bees, honey, pollen, bees wax, propolis, or other substances obtained 20 from honey bees. "Honey bee products" does not include manufactured 21 substances or articles.

22 Sec. 3. RCW 82.12.865 and 2007 c 443 s 2 are each amended to read 23 as follows:

24 (1) The provisions of this chapter do not apply with respect to the ((nonhighway use of diesel fuel, biodiesel fuel, or aircraft fuel, by 25 26 a farm fuel user. This exemption applies to a fuel blend if all of the 27 component fuels of the blend would otherwise be exempt under this subsection if the component fuels were acquired as separate products. 28 Fuel used for space or water heating for human habitation is not exempt 29 under this section)) use of the following fuels by a farm fuel user for 30 agricultural purposes: 31

- 32 <u>(a) Diesel fuel;</u>
- 33 <u>(b) Biodiesel fuel;</u>
- 34 <u>(c) Aircraft fuel; or</u>

35 (d) Fuel blends, provided that all of the component fuels of the 36 blend would otherwise be exempt under this subsection if the component 37 fuels were sold as separate products. 1

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW
to read as follows:

4 (1) This chapter does not apply to amounts received by any person
5 for providing bee pollination services to a farmer using a bee colony
6 owned or kept by the person providing the pollination services.

7 (2) The definitions in RCW 82.04.213 and 82.08.865 apply to this 8 section.

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW 10 to read as follows:

11 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 does not apply to the sale of honey 12 bees to an eligible apiarist, as defined in RCW 82.08.865. This 13 exemption is available only if the buyer provides the seller with an 14 exemption certificate in a form and manner prescribed by the 15 department.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW 17 to read as follows:

18 The provisions of this chapter do not apply in respect to the use 19 of honey bees by an eligible apiarist, as defined in RCW 82.08.865. 20 This exemption is available only if the buyer provides the seller with 21 an exemption certificate in a form and manner prescribed by the 22 department.

23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 7. This act takes effect July 1, 2008.
