1 AN ACT Relating to annexations by hospital districts; and amending 2 RCW 70.44.210, 70.44.220, and 70.44.230.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 70.44.210 and 1967 c 227 s 6 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

As an alternate method of annexation to public hospital districts, 6 7 any territory adjacent to a public hospital district may be annexed 8 thereto by vote of the qualified electors residing in the territory to be annexed, in the manner provided in RCW 70.44.210 through 70.44.230. 9 10 An election to annex such territory may only be called pursuant to a resolution calling for such an election adopted by the district 11 12 commissioners following two public hearings on such a resolution. Both 13 hearings on a resolution must be held within the boundaries of the territory to be annexed. 14

Any resolution calling for such an election shall describe the boundaries of the territory to be annexed, state that the annexation of such territory to the public hospital district will be conducive to the welfare and benefit of the persons or property within the district and within the territory proposed to be annexed, <u>contain the tax</u> implications of the annexation along with how the money will be spent,
and fix the date, time, and place for a public hearing thereon which
date shall be not more than sixty nor less than forty days following
the adoption of such resolution.

5 **Sec. 2.** RCW 70.44.220 and 1967 c 227 s 7 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 Notice of ((such)) each of the two required hearings shall be published once a week for at least ((two)) the three consecutive weeks 8 immediately before the hearings in one or more newspapers of general 9 circulation within the territory proposed to be annexed. 10 If the 11 territory to be annexed is only served by newspapers of general 12 circulation publishing on a monthly or bimonthly basis, notice of the two required hearings shall be published for at least three respective 13 newspaper publishing dates immediately before the hearings. The notice 14 shall contain a description of the boundaries of the territory proposed 15 16 to be annexed, the tax implications of the annexation along with how the money will be spent, and shall state the time and place of the 17 hearing thereon and the fact that any changes in the boundaries of such 18 territory will be considered at such time and place. At such hearings 19 20 or any continuation thereof, any interested person may appear and be 21 heard on all matters relating to the proposed annexation. The district 22 commissioners may make such changes in the boundaries of the territory 23 proposed to be annexed as it shall deem reasonable and proper, but may 24 not delete any portion of the proposed area which will create an island of included or excluded lands. If the district commissioners shall 25 26 determine that any additional territory should be included in the territory to be annexed, ((a second)) an additional hearing shall be 27 held and notice given in the same manner as for the original hearings. 28 The district commissioners may adjourn the hearings on the proposed 29 30 annexation from time to time not exceeding thirty days in all. At the 31 next regular meeting following the conclusion of such hearings, the district commissioners shall, if it finds that the annexation of such 32 territory will be conducive to the welfare and benefit of the persons 33 34 and property therein and the welfare and benefit of the persons and 35 property within the public hospital district, adopt a resolution fixing 36 the boundaries of the territory to be annexed and causing to be called

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1 a special election on such annexation to be held not more than one 2 hundred twenty days nor less than sixty days following the adoption of 3 such resolution.

4 Sec. 3. RCW 70.44.230 and 1967 c 227 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 An election on the annexation of territory to a public hospital 7 district shall be conducted and canvassed in the same manner as provided for the conduct of an election on the formation of a public 8 hospital district except that notice of such election shall be 9 published in one or more newspapers of general circulation in the 10 11 territory proposed to be annexed for the three consecutive weeks 12 immediately before the election and the ballot proposition shall be in 13 substantially the following form:

15 "Shall the territory described in a resolution of the 16 public hospital district commissioners of (((here)) insert name 17 of public hospital district <u>here</u>) adopted on, \ldots \ldots \ldots ((19)) <u>20</u> \ldots , be annexed to such district <u>and</u> 18 should that district impose a permanent regular property tax 19 levy of (insert maximum amount of tax here) or less per 20 21 thousand dollars of the assessed valuation, with money raised 22 under this tax to be spent as follows: (insert how tax money 23 will be spent)?

26 If a majority of those voting on such proposition vote in favor 27 thereof, the territory shall thereupon be annexed to the public 28 hospital district.

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
