- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.225 5 RCW to read as follows:
- Whenever a juvenile fails to appear for a scheduled court hearing under RCW 28A.225.035 and the court issues a bench warrant as a result,
- 8 the court shall also appoint an attorney to represent the juvenile if
- 9 one has not already been appointed.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28A.225 11 RCW to read as follows:
- 12 Except for RCW 28A.225.030(5), the court may order that notice
- 13 required under this chapter be provided by means other than personal
- 14 service but only if personal service has been attempted but has been
- 15 unsuccessful, and service has then been attempted by certified mail but
- 16 returned as unclaimed and the court bases its decision on documents or
- 17 other information indicating that an alternative form of service is

- 1 more likely than not to reach the person to be notified. For purposes
- of this section, "alternative form of service" means certified mail,
- 3 return receipt requested, or regular mail.
