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- 1 AN ACT Relating to prostitution prevention and intervention 2 services funded by the prostitution prevention and intervention
- 3 account; and amending RCW 43.63A.720, 43.63A.730, and 43.63A.740.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 Sec. 1. RCW 43.63A.720 and 1995 c 353 s 7 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
 - (1) There is established in the department of community, trade, and economic development a grant program to enhance funding for prostitution prevention and intervention services, <u>law enforcement training</u>, and <u>community outreach and education</u>. Activities that can be funded through this grant program ((shall provide effective prostitution prevention and intervention services, such as counseling,
- 13 parenting, housing relief, education, and vocational training, that:
- 14 (1) Comprehensively address the problems of persons who are 15 prostitutes; and
- 16 (2) Enhance the ability of persons to leave or avoid prostitution))
 17 include but are not limited to:
- 18 <u>(a) Services directed to address the impact of sexual assault,</u>
 19 <u>residential treatment and services, mental health and chemical</u>

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- 1 dependency services, parenting services, housing assistance, education
- 2 and vocational training, or intensive case management services. These
- 3 activities must (i) address the problems of persons who are either
- 4 prostitutes or minors who have a history of engaging in sexual conduct
- 5 for a fee or who are victims of commercial sexual abuse of a minor or
- 6 both; and (ii) enhance the ability of persons to leave or avoid
- 7 prostitution or to cease or avoid being a victim of commercial sexual
- 8 <u>abuse of a minor; or</u>
- 9 (b) Law enforcement training, community outreach, and education
- 10 regarding prostitution and minors who have a history of engaging in
- 11 <u>sexual conduct for a fee or are the victims of commercial sexual abuse</u>
- 12 of a minor, including law enforcement training regarding the
- 13 <u>availability of services for minors under chapter 13.32A RCW.</u>
- 14 (2) For the purposes of this section, "commercial sexual abuse of
- 15 <u>a minor</u>" has the same meaning as provided in RCW 9.68A.100.
- 16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.63A.730 and 1995 c 353 s 9 are each amended to read 17 as follows:
- 18 (1) At a minimum, grant applications to provide services under RCW
- 19 43.63A.720(1)(a) must include the following:
- 20 $((\frac{1}{1}))$ (a) The proposed geographic service area;
- 21 $((\frac{2}{2}))$ A description of the extent and effect of the needs for
- 22 prostitution prevention and intervention within the relevant geographic
- 23 area;
- 24 $((\frac{3}{3}))$ (c) An explanation of how the funds will be used, their
- 25 relationship to existing services available within the community, and
- 26 the need that they will fulfill;
- 27 $((\frac{4}{}))$ (\underline{d}) An explanation of what organizations were involved in
- the development of the proposal; and
- 29 $((\frac{5}{}))$ The methods that will be employed to measure the
- 30 success of the program.

- 32 43.63A.720(1)(b) must include the following:
- 33 (a) The proposed geographic outreach and education area or proposed
- 34 <u>selected law enforcement population, as applicable;</u>
- 35 (b) An explanation of how the funds will be used, their
- 36 <u>relationship to existing training, outreach or education services</u>
- 37 <u>available within the community, and the need that they will fulfill;</u>
