AN ACT Relating to capital grants for integrated long-term care worker training labs in the community and technical college system; creating a new section; and making appropriations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. Subject to funding provided specifically for 6 the purposes of this section, the state board for community and 7 technical colleges, in consultation with the exclusive bargaining 8 representative of individual providers under RCW 74.39A.270, shall 9 allocate capital grants on a competitive basis to up to four community 10 college pilot sites for the delivery of training and workforce development services for long-term care workers required under chapter 11 12 74.39A RCW. Moneys must be used to renovate or expand existing community college facilities, or to acquire land and facilities in 13 14 close proximity to a community college campus, to accommodate programs 15 that provide home and community-like long-term care settings, including the installation of durable medical equipment such as assistive 16 devices, lifts, and remote technologies. Community colleges eligible 17 to participate in the pilot program must be located in a county with a 18 19 population of two hundred thousand or more. Priority consideration

- must be given to community college applicants: (a) With existing allied health care programs; and (b) that can demonstrate tangible commitments to the project by business or other community partners.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of two million dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 2009, from the state building construction account to the state board for community and technical colleges for the purposes of this act.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The sum of four hundred thousand dollars, or 10 as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal 11 year ending June 30, 2009, from the general fund to the state board for 12 community and technical colleges for the purposes of this act.
