## SENATE BILL 6875

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State of Washington 60th Legislature 2008 Regular Session

- 1 AN ACT Relating to creation of the condominium act governance task
- 2 force; creating new sections; and providing an expiration date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that many Washington
- 5 residents are impacted by the laws governing condominium associations
- 6 found in chapter 64.34 RCW. The legislature further finds that the
- 7 impact of these laws is of significant importance because these laws
- 8 affect both a unit owner's property values and his or her sense of
- 9 security and happiness in his or her home and community. The
- 10 legislature recognizes that the provisions regulating condominium
- 11 governance in chapter 64.34 RCW should be thoroughly reviewed to ensure
- 12 transparency and openness in condominium governance.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) The condominium act governance task
- 14 force is created with ten members as provided in this subsection.
- 15 (a) The majority leader of the senate shall appoint one member from
- 16 the senate.
- 17 (b) The speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint one
- 18 member from the house of representatives.

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- 1 (c) The majority leader of the senate and the speaker of the house 2 of representatives jointly shall appoint eight nonlegislative members 3 of the task force, which shall include three condominium board members 4 representing three different condominium associations, three unit 5 owners who own a unit that is their primary residence in a condominium 6 that is governed by chapter 64.34 RCW, and two attorneys with expertise 7 in condominium governance.
  - (2) The task force shall:

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- 9 (a) Convene as soon as possible upon the appointment of its 10 members;
- 11 (b) Elect a chair and adopt rules for conducting the business of the task force;
- 13 (c) Thoroughly study condominium association governance law including, but not limited to, the following:
- 15 (i) The provisions regulating condominium association governance 16 contained in chapter 64.34 RCW;
- 17 (ii) Statutes regulating condominium associations in other states; 18 and
  - (iii) Other model statutes the task force deems relevant;
  - (d) Determine and document perceived and actual shortcomings of the condominium governance statutes contained in chapter 64.34 RCW;
    - (e) Draft proposed legislation revising the condominium governance statutes in chapter 64.34 RCW if the task force determines that the statutes could be improved in any way; and
    - (f) Take public testimony for at least thirty minutes at every second meeting.
  - (3) Staff support for the task force must be provided by the senate committee services and the house of representatives office of program research.
- 30 (4) Legislative members of the task force must be reimbursed for 31 travel expenses in accordance with RCW 44.04.120.
- 32 (5) The task force shall report its findings and any proposed 33 legislation to the legislature by September 10, 2008.
  - (6) This section expires December 31, 2008.

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
