- 13 The appropriation in this section is subject to the following 14 conditions and limitations:
- 15 (1) \$49,976,500 of the appropriation in fiscal year 2010 and
- 16 \$49,976,500 of the appropriation in fiscal year 2011 are provided
- 17 solely for the higher education coordinating board to develop and
- 18 implement a competitive high demand enrollment grant process. The
- 19 board will manage a competitive process to award at least 8,250 FTE
- 20 student enrollments in high-demand fields at a state budgeted rate of
- 21 \$11,000 per FTE. Public four year institutions are eligible to apply
- 22 for high demand enrollments. Selected programs shall demonstrate need

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EFFECT: Removes \$100,133,000 in state general obligation bond funding for the Trust Land Transfer program under the Department of Natural Resources and provides \$100,133,000 for the higher education coordinating board to implement a competitive high demand enrollment grant process for public four-year colleges and universities.
