- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 46.36

- 17 (4) The intersection is controlled by a vehicle-activated traffic 18 control signal that fails to detect the motorcycle;

- 21 (6) The operator of the motorcycle exercises due care before 22 proceeding to turn left or travel straight through the intersection;
