- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) Within existing resources, the higher 4 education coordinating board shall convene a work group on simplifying 5 and consolidating student financial assistance. The work group shall 6 include one member from the student financial assistance division of 7 the higher education coordinating board and one member from the 8 student services division of the state board for community and
- 9 technical colleges, one financial aid administrator from a four-year
- 10 institution of higher education, one financial aid administrator from
- 11 a community or technical college, one member from the employment
- 12 security department, and one member from the council of presidents
- 13 office.
- 14 (2) The committee shall prepare a plan to streamline, promote,
- 15 and expand access to financial aid programs. In developing the plan,
- 16 the higher education coordinating board and their partners,
- 17 identified in this section, shall take the following actions:
- 18 (a) Conduct an analysis of all the existing financial aid programs
- 19 including the populations served, total state expenditures dedicated
- 20 to each program, average award levels per student, and the number of
- 21 staff dedicated to program administration;
- 22 (b) Based on the analysis outlined in section (a) of this
- 23 subsection, develop recommendations on the programs that provide the
- 24 greatest value to the largest number of students, the programs that
- 25 best meet state access and affordability goals, and a process and
- 26 timeline for implementing these recommendations;

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- 1 (c) Develop an incentive system to assure that the state's 2 investment in student financial assistance increases completion and
- 3 career placement rates and rewards institutions that efficiently
- 4 produce highly skilled graduates, ready for work in high-demand
- 5 occupations.
- 6 (3) The higher education coordinating board shall submit the 7 report to the appropriate committees of the legislature by December 1, 8 2009."

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10 Correct the title.

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EFFECT: Replaces all provisions in the substitute bill with a directive to prepare a plan to streamline, promote, and expand access to financial aid programs.

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
