EFFECT: Specifies that the State Treasurer must retain twenty cents per month for each switched access line, radio access line, and interconnected voice over internet protocol service line whos place of primary use is in a county with a population of more than 700,000 but less than 1,000,000, until that county: (1) reaches an operational agreement regarding how enhanced 911 service will be delivered; and (2) secures approval from the State E-911 Coordinator.
