1 On page 2, after line 1, insert the following:

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3 **"Sec. 2.** RCW 67.70.340 and 2005 c 369 s 4 are each amended to 4 read as follows:

5 (1) The legislature recognizes that creating a shared game lottery 6 could result in less revenue being raised by the existing state 7 lottery ticket sales. The legislature further recognizes that the two impacted by this potential event are the 8 funds most student 9 achievement fund and the education construction account. Therefore, 10 it is the intent of the legislature to use some of the proceeds from 11 the shared game lottery to make up the difference that the potential 12 state lottery revenue loss would have on the student achievement fund 13 and the education construction account. The legislature further 14 intends to use some of the proceeds from the shared game lottery to 15 fund programs and services related to problem and pathological 16 gambling.

17 (2) The commission shall transfer all net revenues derived from 18 the shared game lottery "Powerball" authorized in section 1(1) of this 19 act to the student achievement fund.

20 (((2)))(3) The student achievement fund and the education 21 construction account are expected to collectively receive one hundred 22 two million dollars annually from state lottery games other than the 23 shared game lottery. For fiscal year 2003 and thereafter, if the 24 amount of lottery revenues earmarked for the student achievement fund 25 and the education construction account is less than one hundred two 26 million dollars, the commission, after making the transfer<u>s</u> required 27 under subsections (((3))) (2) and (4) of this section, must transfer 1 sufficient moneys from revenues derived from the shared game lottery 2 into the student achievement fund and the education construction 3 account to bring the total revenue up to one hundred two million 4 dollars. The funds transferred from the shared game lottery account 5 under this subsection must be divided between the student achievement 6 fund and the education construction account in a manner consistent 7 with RCW 67.70.240(3).

8 (((3)))<u>(4)</u>(a) The commission shall transfer, from revenue derived 9 from the shared game lottery, to the problem gambling account created 10 in RCW 43.20A.892, an amount equal to the percentage specified in (b) 11 of this subsection of net receipts. For purposes of this subsection, 12 "net receipts" means the difference between (i) revenue received from 13 the sale of lottery tickets or shares and revenue received from the 14 sale of shared game lottery tickets or shares; and (ii) the sum of 15 payments made to winners.

16 (b) In fiscal year 2006, the percentage to be transferred to the 17 problem gambling account is one-tenth of one percent. In fiscal year 18 2007 and subsequent fiscal years, the percentage to be transferred to 19 the problem gambling account is thirteen one-hundredths of one 20 percent.

21 (((4))) (5) The remaining net revenues, if any, in the shared game 22 lottery account after the transfers pursuant to this section shall be 23 deposited into the general fund."

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25 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal 26 references accordingly.
