- 4 "Sec. 1. RCW 46.16.076 and 2007 c 340 s 1 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1)(a) The department shall provide an opportunity for owners of 7 vehicles registered under RCW 46.16.0621 and vehicles licensed under 8 RCW 46.16.070 with a declared gross weight of ten thousand pounds or 9 less, to make a voluntary donation of five dollars at the time of 10 initial or renewal registration. The donation must be deposited in 11 the state parks renewal and stewardship account established in RCW 12 79A.05.215 to be used for the operation and maintenance of state 13 parks.
- 14 (b) The department in consultation with the parks and recreation
  15 commission shall develop a public education program to raise public
  16 awareness about the importance of making a donation for the support
  17 and maintenance of state parks, with a goal of increasing the rate of
- 18 donations to state parks through voluntary vehicle registrations.
- 19 (2) This section applies to registrations due or to become due on 20 or after January 1, 2008.
- 21 (3) The state parks and recreation commission shall not close any
- 22 parks during the 2009-11 biennium. By January 10, 2010, the state
- 23 parks and recreation commission shall provide a report to the
- 24 legislature on their budget and resources related to operating parks
- 25 for the remainder of the biennium.

**EFFECT:** Directs the Department of Licensing in cooperation with the State Parks and Recreation Commission (Commission) to develop a public education campaign to increase voluntary donations to state parks through vehicle registrations. Requires the Commission to not close any state parks during the 2009-11 biennium, and to report to the legislature by January 10, 2010, on its budget and resources. Includes an emergency clause.
