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3	"(2) All hospitals receiving five hundred thousand dollars or more
4	from the hospital safety net assessment fund, as a condition of
5	receiving the funds, shall apply to the Washington state quality award
6	or similar organization such as the Baldridge national quality program
7	for an organization-wide Baldridge assessment within two years and a
8	full assessment every three years thereafter in order to improve the
9	efficiency and effectiveness of hospitals receiving these funds. Each
10	hospital shall commit and plan to become a high performance, high
11	integrity organization and reach a score of sixty percent in ten
12	years. Washington state quality award applications, assessment
13	feedback reports, and corrective action plans shall:
14	(a) Be sent to the department to ensure public accountability,
15	sharing of best practices among hospitals, and adequate performance
16	management improvement;
17	(b) Be electronically sent to the Washington state auditor's
18	office to assist in its analysis of hospital performance data,
19	performance measures, and self-assessment systems; and

(c) Be used by the department for identification of best practices 20 21 for developing the quality incentive benchmarks under subsection (1) 22 of this section."

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24 Renumber subsections consecutively and correct any internal 25 references accordingly.

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EFFECT: Requires hospitals receiving \$500,000 or more from the Hospital Safety Net Assessment Fund to apply for a Baldridge assessment within two years and a full assessment every three years thereafter.

Requires the Department of Social and Health Services to use the outcomes of the Baldridge assessments in its development of quality incentive benchmarks.

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
