- On page 6, after line 25 of the amendment, insert the following:
- 2 "(3) The department may use the state printing plant only to
- 3 provide public printing work or supplies to state agencies,
- 4 <u>institutions of higher education</u>, and other institutions of state

- 6 On page 7, line 25 of the amendment, after "Whenever" strike "in
- 7 the judgment of the ((public printer)) department and insert ((in the
- 8 judgment of the public printer))"
- 9 On page 7, at the beginning of line 29 of the amendment, strike
- 10 "department" and insert "any agency"
- On page 8, beginning on line 3 of the amendment, after "(2)" strike
- 12 all material through "(3)" on line 10, and insert "((In event any work
- 13 or supplies are secured on behalf of the state under this section the
- 14 state printing plant shall be entitled to add up to five percent to the
- 15 cost thereof to cover the handling of the orders which shall be added
- 16 to the bills and charged to the respective authorities ordering the
- 17 work or supplies. The five percent handling charge shall not apply to
- 18 contracts with institutions of higher education.
- 19 (3))"
- On page 8, after line 14 of the amendment, insert the following:
- 21 "Sec. 14. RCW 43.78.130 and 1999 c 365 s 1 are each amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 All printing, binding, and stationery work done for any state
- 24 agency((, county, city, town, port district, or school district)) or
- 25 <u>institution of higher education</u> in this state shall be done within the
- 26 state, and all proposals, requests, or invitations to submit bids,

- prices, or contracts thereon, and all contracts for such work, shall so 1 2 PROVIDED, That whenever it is established that any such work cannot be executed within the state, or that the lowest charge for 3 which it can be procured within the state, exceeds the charge usually 4 5 and customarily made to private individuals and corporations for work of similar character and quality, or that all bids for the work or any 6 7 part thereof are excessive and not reasonably competitive, the officers 8 of any such public corporation may have the work done outside the state." 9
- 10 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct any internal 11 references accordingly, and correct the title.
- On page 12, line 9 of the amendment, after "That," insert "except for office printers and printer services as defined in RCW 43.105.020,"
 - EFFECT: (1) Removes the authority for the public printer to add a five percent markup to printing work or supplies.
 - (2) Specifies that any agency may obtain printing work or supplies from private sources if it is more economical than using the state printing plant.
 - (3) Specifies that the state printing plant only may be used to provide public printing work or supplies to state agencies, institutions of higher education, or other institutions of state government.
 - (4) Exempts office printers and printer services from the list of products and services that state agencies are prohibited from acquiring or disposing of without receiving a delegation of authority from the information services board to do so.
