- 6 Article 1, section 20 of the Constitution of the state of Washington
- 7 by adding a new section to read as follows:
- 8 Article I, section 20. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 9 this Constitution, all persons charged with crime shall be bailable by
- 10 sufficient sureties, except for capital offenses and offenses for
- 11 which the maximum sentence is the possibility of life in prison, when
- 12 the proof is evident, or the presumption great.
- 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause
- 14 notice of this constitutional amendment to be published at least four
- 15 times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal
- 16 newspaper in the state.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this act shall be known as the
- 18 Lakewood law enforcement memorial act."

EFFECT: Removes the language giving judges the discretion to deny bail to a person charged with a crime if only the pretrial detention of the person will reasonably assure public safety.

Provides that, notwithstanding any provision of the Constitution, a judge may deny bail to a person charged with an offense for which the maximum sentence is the possibility of life in prison.
