- (ii) It is the intent of the legislature that \$144,505,000 of transportation partnership account future appropriation be applied to project 840508A, as identified in the LEAP transportation document in subsection (1) of this section: I-405/NE 44th St to 112th Ave SE Widening, so as to deliver the project by the end of the 2021-2023 biennium as provided in LEAP Transportation Document 2008-1, Highway Improvement Program (I) as developed March 10, 2008.
- (iii) It is the intent of the legislature the amount of transportation partnership account funds programmed in the future for project 809936Z, as identified in the LEAP transportation document in subsection (1) of this section: the Alaskan Way viaduct replacement

1 project, be reduced by the amounts required to fund the projects in 2 subsections (b)(i) and (b)(ii) of this subsection."

EFFECT: Advances the I-405/NE 132nd New Interchange and the I-405/NE 44th St to 112th Ave SE Widening projects to the schedule in the financial plan developed by the 2008 legislature. Funds the I-405 projects with transportation partnership account (TPA) funds currently programmed on the Alaskan Way Viaduct replacement project.
