On page 5 of the amendment, line 25, increase the Motor Vehicle 1 2 Account--State appropriation by \$350,000 3 4 On page 6 of the amendment, after line 10, insert the following: 5 6 "(3) \$350,000 of the motor vehicle account--state appropriation is 7 for an independent analysis of methodologies to value the reversible 8 lanes on interstate 90 to be used for high capacity transit pursuant 9 to sound transit proposition 1 approved by voters in November 2008. 10 The independent analysis shall be conducted by sound transit and the 11 department of transportation, using consultant resources 12 appropriate by the secretary of the department, the chief executive 13 officer of sound transit, and the co-chairs of the 14 transportation committee. It shall be conducted in consultation with 15 the federal transit and federal highway administrations and account 16 for applicable federal laws, regulations and practices. It shall also 1976 interstate 90 memorandum of agreement and 17 account for the 18 subsequent 2004 amendment and the 1978 federal secretary of 19 transportation's environmental decision on interstate 90. The 20 department and sound transit must provide periodic reports to the 21 joint transportation committee, the sound transit board of directors, 22 and the governor, and report final recommendations by September 1, 23 2009."

On page 36 of the amendment, beginning on line 8, strike all of subsection (17) and insert the following:

"(17) The legislature is committed to the timely completion of R8A which supports the construction of sound transit's east link. Following the completion of the independent analysis of the methodologies to value the reversible lanes on interstate 90 which may be used for high capacity transit as directed in section 204 of this act, the department shall complete the process of negotiations with sound transit. Such agreement shall be completed no later than Becember 1, 2009."

EFFECT: Provides funding to the Joint Transportation Committee for Sound Transit and the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to conduct an independent analysis of the valuation of the reversible lanes on Interstate 90 between Seattle and Bellevue. Following the analysis, requires the WSDOT to complete negotiations with Sound Transit, with an agreement no later than December 1, 2009.
