3 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 26.60 4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) The legislature has expressly declared that Washington state 6 has a compelling state interest in reaffirming its historical 7 commitment to the institution of marriage as a union between a man and 8 a woman as husband and wife and in protecting that institution, and 9 has further declared its intent to establish public policy against 10 same-sex marriage that clearly and definitively declares same-sex 11 marriages will not be recognized in Washington, even if they are made 12 legal in other states.

13 (2) The legislature has enacted statutory law that prohibits 14 marriages when the parties are persons other than a male and a female, 15 and provides that marriages between two persons other than a male and 16 a female that are recognized as valid in other jurisdictions are not 17 valid or recognized in this state.

18 (3) Nothing in this act, or any other provision of this code, is 19 intended, or shall be construed, to modify or supersede state law 20 pertaining to what constitutes marriage, to promote or endorse same-21 sex marriage or any specific belief, practice, behavior, preference, 22 or orientation, or to denominate registered domestic partnerships as 23 lawful marriage since that nomenclature applies only to marriage 24 between a man and a woman as husband and wife under existing state 25 law."

EFFECT: Provides that the legislature has expressly prohibited same-sex marriage and the recognition of same-sex marriages from other jurisdictions, and that this act and any other provision in the code are not intended to, and shall not be construed to, modify or supersede the state law regarding what constitutes marriage.
