- 5 (1) The legislature recognizes that the First Amendment to the 6 United States Constitution provides that "Congress shall make no law 7 respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free 8 exercise thereof...." and Article I, section 11 of the Washington 9 state Constitution provides that "Absolute freedom of conscience in 10 all matters of religious sentiment, belief and worship, shall be 11 guaranteed to every individual...."
- (2) The legislature further recognizes that there is a substantial and distinct difference between a person's discriminating decisions or 14 acts based on one's view of another person's sexual orientation versus 15 a person's discriminating decisions or acts based on one's view of 16 marriage, including marriage as a civil union only between one man and 17 one woman. The legislature further finds that such decisions or acts 18 are not one and the same since one decision or act is based on a 19 person's view of sexual orientation and the other decision or act is 20 based on a person's view of marriage, regardless of a person's sexual 21 orientation.

- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 26.60 RCW 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (1) The legislature recognizes that the First Amendment to the 15 United States Constitution provides that "Congress shall make no 16 law...abridging the freedom of speech...." and Article I, section 5 of 17 the Washington state Constitution provides that "Every person may 18 freely speak, write and publish on all subjects, being responsible for 19 the abuse of that right."
- 20 (2) The legislature further recognizes that there is a substantial 21 and distinct difference between lawfully expressing one's belief or 22 opinion for or against domestic partnerships based on one's view of a 23 person's sexual orientation versus lawfully expressing one's beliefs 24 or opinions for or against domestic partnerships based on one's view 25 of marriage, including marriage as a civil union only between one man 26 and one woman. The legislature further finds that such expressions of 27 belief are not one and the same since one form of speech is based on 28 the person's view of a person's sexual orientation and the other form 29 of speech is based on the person's view of marriage, regardless of a 30 person's sexual orientation.

NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 26.60 RCW 33 to read as follows:

EFFECT: Recognizes the provisions on freedom of speech and freedom of religion granted by the U.S. and state Constitutions.

Provides that the Legislature recognizes that there is a difference between a discriminating decision or act, or the lawful expression of one's belief, based on one's view of a person's sexual orientation versus a discriminating decision or act, or the lawful expression of one's belief, based on one's view of what constitutes marriage.

Provides that a person, organization, or religious entity is immune from civil and criminal liability for: (1) lawful speech expressing its beliefs about domestic partnerships and civil unions and its beliefs about marriage; and (2) lawfully acting consistently with its sincerely held religious beliefs by refusing to participate in, endorse, facilitate, or otherwise assist any marriage, marriage ceremony, reception or other activity, or any domestic partnership, domestic partnership ceremony, reception, or other activity.
