- 1 On page 2, after line 34 of the striking amendment, insert the 2 following:
- 3 "(10) For the 2009-10 academic year, tuition fees charged to full-
- 4 time resident undergraduate students may increase no greater than
- 5 fourteen percent over the previous academic year in any institution of
- 6 higher education.
- 7 (11) Beginning with the 2010-11 academic year, any action or
- 8 combination of actions by the legislature that raises undergraduate
- 9 resident tuition above the annual state median wage growth rate, as
- 10 calculated by the office of financial management, may be taken only if
- 11 approved by a two-thirds vote of each house of the legislature."

**EFFECT:** For the 2009-10 academic year, resident undergraduate tuition may increase no greater than 14% over the rate charged in the previous academic year. Requires a 2/3 vote of both houses in order for the Legislature to increase resident undergraduate tuition above the annual state median wage growth rate as calculated by OFM.
