- On page 9, beginning on line 1 of the striking amendment, strike all of subsection (10) and insert the following:
- 3 "(10) ((The penalties)) (a) Two hundred dollars from each full
- 4 penalty imposed under subsections (7), (8), and (9) of this section
- 5 shall be allocated as follows:
- 6 (i) One hundred dollars shall be deposited in the accessible
- 7 communities account created in section 2 of this act; and
- 8 (ii) One hundred dollars shall be deposited in the multimodal
- 9 account under RCW 47.66.070 for the sole purpose of supplementing a
- 10 grant program for special needs transportation provided by transit
- 11 agencies and nonprofit providers of transportation that is
- 12 administered by the department of transportation.
- (b) When a reduced penalty is imposed under subsections (7),(8),
- 14 or (9) of this section, the amount deposited in the accounts
- 15 identified in subsection (a) of this subsection shall be reduced
- 16 equally and proportionally. The remaining penalty amounts shall be
- 17 used by that local jurisdiction exclusively for law enforcement. The
- 18 court may also impose an additional penalty sufficient to reimburse
- 19 the local jurisdiction for any costs it may have incurred in removal
- 20 and storage of the improperly parked vehicle."

22 **EFFECT:**

- Establishes that the collected penalty amounts must be allocated equally between the Accessible Communities

 Account and the Transportation Multimodal Account.
- Provides that the funds deposited in the Transportation
 Multimodal Account shall only be used to supplement a
 grant program for special needs transportation provided
 by transit agencies and nonprofit providers.
