- 5 Except as provided in RCW 50.20.--- (section 2, chapter 3, Laws 6 of 2009), benefits shall be payable as provided in this section.
- 7 (1) For claims with an effective date on or after April 4, 2004,
- 8 benefits shall be payable to any eligible individual during the
- 9 individual's benefit year in a maximum amount equal to the lesser of
- 10 twenty-six times the weekly benefit amount, as determined in
- 11 subsection (2) of this section, or one-third of the individual's
- 12 base year wages under this title.
- 13 (2) For claims with an effective date on or after April 24,
- 14 2005, an individual's weekly benefit amount shall be an amount equal
- 15 to three and eighty-five one-hundredths percent of the average
- 16 quarterly wages of the individual's total wages during the two
- 17 quarters of the individual's base year in which such total wages
- 18 were highest.
- 19 (3)(a) For claims with an effective date on or after January 3,
- 20 2010, in addition to the amount payable weekly under subsection (2)
- 21 of this section, an individual shall be paid a dependent allowance
- 22 of five dollars weekly for: (i) Each child who is a dependent of the
- 23 individual for federal income tax exemptions; and (ii) each child
- 24 for whom the individual owes child support obligations and for whom
- 25 no other person is receiving dependent allowances under this
- 26 subsection.
- 27 (b) For the purposes of this subsection:

- (i) "Child" means a biological, adopted, or foster child, a stepchild, a legal ward, or a child of a person standing in loco parentis who is: (A) Under eighteen years of age; (B) eighteen years of age or older and incapable of self-care because of a mental or physical disability; or (C) under twenty-four years of age, enrolled
- 6 <u>as a student, and regularly attending classes, or is between two</u> 7 successive academic years or terms, at an institution of higher
- 8 education.
- 9 <u>(ii) "Institution of higher education" means an educational</u>
 10 institution that: (A) Admits as regular students only individuals
- 11 having a certificate of graduation from a high school, or the
- 12 recognized equivalent of such a certificate; (B) is legally
- 13 authorized to provide a program of education beyond high school; (C)
- 14 provides an educational program for which it awards a bachelor's or
- 15 higher degree, or provides a program which is acceptable for full
- 16 credit toward such a degree, or offers a program of training to
- 17 prepare students for gainful employment in a recognized occupation;
- 18 and (D) is a public or other nonprofit institution.
- 19 $\underline{(4)}$ The maximum and minimum amounts payable weekly shall be
- 20 determined as of each June 30th to apply to benefit years beginning
- 21 in the twelve-month period immediately following such June 30th.
- 22 (a) The maximum amount payable weekly shall be either four
- 23 hundred ninety-six dollars or sixty-three percent of the "average
- 24 weekly wage" for the calendar year preceding such June 30th,
- 25 whichever is greater.
- 26 (b) The minimum amount payable weekly shall be fifteen percent
- 27 of the "average weekly wage" for the calendar year preceding such
- 28 June 30th.
