The court shall consider any objective evidence 6 of weekly, biweekly, or monthly personal verbal, written, or 7 electronic contact, and annual in-person interactions on holidays, 8 birthdays, and other events as evidence of such involvement" 9 On page 4, beginning on line 5 of the striking amendment, after 10 11 "(b)" strike all material through "death" on line 8 and insert 12 ""Significant involvement" means objective evidence of personal, 13 verbal, written, electronic, or in-person contact with an adult child 14 on a frequent basis. The court shall consider any objective evidence 15 of weekly, biweekly, or monthly personal verbal, written, or 16 electronic contact, and annual in-person interactions on holidays, 17 birthdays, and other events as evidence of such involvement" 18 On page 5, beginning on line 9 of the striking amendment, after 19 20 "(b)" strike all material through "death" on line 12 and insert 21 ""Significant involvement" means objective evidence of personal, 22 verbal, written, electronic, or in-person contact with a child on a 23 frequent basis. The court shall consider any objective evidence of 24 weekly, biweekly, or monthly personal verbal, written, or electronic 25 contact, and annual in-person interactions on holidays, birthdays, and 26 other events as evidence of such involvement"

**EFFECT:** Changes the definition of significant involvement to require personal, verbal, written, electronic, or in-person contact with the child on a frequent basis. Provides that the court must consider any objective evidence of weekly, biweekly, or monthly personal verbal, written, electronic, and annual in-person interactions on holidays, birthdays, and other events as evidence of such involvement. (The underlying striking amendment defines the term as "demonstrated support of an emotional, psychological, or financial nature within the relationship, at or near the time of death or the time of the incident causing death.")
