1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10  
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) It is the intent of the legislature that state universities  
6 engage in the commercialization of research and other economic  
7 development and workforce development activities that benefit the  
8 intermediate and long-term economic vitality of Washington. State  
9 universities are expected to develop and strengthen university-industry  
10 relationships through the conduct of research, the support of company  
11 formation and job generation, and collaborative training. The state  
12 universities, using in-house university resources and not contractors,  
13 must perform one or more of the following functions:

14 (a) Provide collaborative research and technology transfer  
15 opportunities;

16 (b) Publicize their commercialization processes and include an  
17 explanation of how to access commercialization resources at the  
18 universities;

19 (c) Develop mechanisms for pairing researchers, entrepreneurs, and  
20 investors. Such mechanisms are to include, but are not limited to,  
21 developing guides, web sites, or workshops on funding opportunities, on  
22 entrepreneurship and the process of starting a company, and on  
23 university-industry relations;

24 (d) Host events to connect researchers to entrepreneurs, investors,  
25 and individuals from the state's technology-based industries; and

26 (e) Provide opportunities for training undergraduate and graduate  
27 students through direct involvement in research and industry  
28 interactions.

29 (2) In carrying out the functions in this section, the universities  
30 may work with and through the higher education coordinating board.

1        NEW SECTION.   **Sec. 2.**   A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW  
2   to read as follows:

3        To support the formation of companies created around the  
4   technologies developed at state universities, the state universities  
5   are authorized to establish and administer bridge-funding programs for  
6   start-up companies using funds from the federal government and the  
7   private sector."

8        Correct the title.

EFFECT:   The amendment:   (1) Requires the state universities to  
use in-house resources, not contractors, to perform functions on the  
list of commercialization activities; (2) deletes the provisions  
amending the State Ethics Act; (3) codifies the sections relating to  
commercialization activities in a chapter of law that defines "state  
universities" as the University of Washington and Washington State  
Universities; and (4) clarifies that the bridge funding program relates  
to supporting the formation of companies created around the  
technologies developed at state universities.

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
