### **HB 1268**

**Brief Description**: Concerning the relinquishment of a water right.

**Sponsors**: Representatives Warnick, Chandler, Hinkle, Newhouse, Blake, Ross, Johnson, Smith, McCune, Condotta and Kretz.

#### **Brief Summary of Bill**

• Allows the continuance of a water right if the owner uses at least a portion of the water right for the established purpose of use.

#### Background:

A water right is relinquished when the owner does not use all or a portion of his or her water for five consecutive years without showing sufficient cause.

The Department of Ecology (DOE) may determine when a water right has been relinquished and reverted to the state. A person may appeal the DOE findings to the Pollution Control Hearings Board.

#### **Summary of Bill:**

An owner of a water right does not relinquish his or her claim on the water if he or she continues to use at least a portion of the water for the established purpose of use.
