• Authorizes the Washington State Patrol to accept donations, bequests, gifts, conveyances, devices, grants, money, property or other things of value.

Background:

The Washington State Patrol (WSP) is authorized by statute to accept donations, grants, bequests, money and property for the fire service training program.

Summary of Bill:

The WSP may accept donations, grants, bequests, money and property for any purpose in fulfilling its mission.

Appropriation: None.

Fiscal Note: Not requested.

Effective Date: The bill takes effect 90 days after adjournment of the session in which the bill is passed.
