# **Brief Summary of Engrossed Substitute Bill**

• Making supplemental operating appropriations for the 2009-11 biennium.

## Background:

The state government operates on a fiscal biennium that begins July 1 of each odd-numbered year. The 2009-11 biennial operating budget, as amended by ESHB 2921 (Chapter 3, Laws of 2010), appropriated \$31.3 billion from the State General Fund and the Education Legacy Trust Account, (together referred to as Near General Fund-State). The total budgeted amount, which includes state and federal funds, is \$58.7 billion.

## **Summary of Bill:**

Appropriations are modified for the 2009-11 biennium. Near General Fund-State appropriations are reduced by \$379
