- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The department of veterans affairs shall 5 study efficient ways to increase the department's access to veterans, and to increase veterans' access to the state and federal assistance 6 programs for which they may be eligible. By December 1, 2009, the shall 8 department submit a report to the legislature with 9 recommendations. The report shall address:
 - (1) How the department can achieve a goal of identifying all veterans in the state within five years;
- 12 (2) How the department can efficiently identify veterans as their population in the state continues to grow;
 - (3) How the department can identify veterans through referrals from other state agencies that currently provide services to veterans;
- 16 (4) How the department can effectively inform veterans of the state 17 and federal programs for which they may be eligible;
- 18 (5) The potential costs and savings to the state that would result 19 if the department's recommendations were undertaken; and
